Shortly after Liberty's announcement to begin sponsoring lacrosse in 2010, Regan Denham was named the head coach. As Liberty's first head coach, Denham led the Lady Flames to their first win on March 6, 2010, defeating Howard, 17-16, in overtime.

In 2011, Denham's team made a six-win improvement from its inaugural season and also chalked up a postseason victory, defeating Howard in the National Lacrosse Conference Tournament, 16-13.

A trio of Denham's student-athletes garnered post season honors following the conclusion of the 2012 season. Junior Chloe McIntosh was named to the NLC second team all-conference squad, all-academic team, as well as the VaSID all-state team. Jen Moyer garnered a spot on the NLC all-academic team and Kacie Fogle was tabbed for the all-tournament team following the conclusion of the NLC tournament.

Prior to coming to Lynchburg, Denham served as head coach at Springfield College and Missouri Baptist University. She also acted as assistant coach and interim head coach at Averett and Drew Universities, respectively.
